# Gender Statistics

*‘A field of statistics which cuts across the traditional fields adequately reflecting differences and inequalities in the situation of women and men in all areas of life’*

- data are collected and presented **disaggregated by sex** as a primary and overall classification
- data are reflecting **gender issues**
- data are based on **concepts and definitions** that adequately capture all aspects of women and men’s lives
- data collection methods take into account **stereotypes and social and cultural factors** that may induce gender biases

# Why a Gender perspective?

- data **disaggregated by sex** are not exhaustive
- **social relationship** between women and men are more relevant than biological differences
- important instrument for **Monitoring & Evaluation**
- fundamental tool to **mainstream gender** and develop **gender sensitive policies**

# The Goals

- awareness raising on how to produce and use gender statistics data/Identify statistics gaps
- encourage Member States to produce and use gender statistics
- Make visible the different contribution of women and men to economic growth

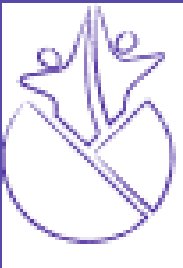

# Why a statistics database?

## EIGE's founding regulation

*“the Institute should assist the Member States in the collection, analysis and dissemination of objective, reliable and comparable information and data on equality between women and men”*

## EIGE's Work Programmes

*“set up a documentation centre (in physical and online form), providing the public with easy access to **statistics, data, information**, functioning models and approaches to gender mainstreaming”*

# EIGE's Gender Statistics database

A collection of statistical data and associated metadata pertaining specifically to the area of gender statistics

Publicly available

Logically grouping indicators/structured guide for selecting statistics

Tree-based browsing interface and keyword search

Updating with new available data

Data and metadata

Presents the Index-relevant statistics along with other types of gender statistics

# What's New?

- ***Centralised source***
  - A single database providing access to gender statistics
  - Index-relevant statistics
  - Interface: tree-based + keyword search
- ***Metadata with gender equality concepts/methods***

# What's New?

- ***Computed data***
  - Allows comparisons in time and between countries
  - Derived gender statistics
- ***“Automated” updating of data and metadata***

  - Policymakers (EU and national)
  - Academic researchers

  - Civil Society

- User diversity necessitates multiple entry points/ browsing trees

# Gender Equality Index

- Defines and measures gender equality
- Provides a policy tool
- Specific methodology to analyse gender gaps
- Highlights statistics gaps
- Supports evidence/Stimulates debate

# Gender Equality Index: data transformation

**Multivariate analysis: grouping variables in homogeneous clusters**  
***-Domains and subdomains-***

- Based on the internal structure of the data
- Provides statistical support to the conceptual framework
- Creates the measurement framework

# Gender statistics/Gender Equality Index

Gender statistics database adopts a wider perspective including **input, process, output** and indicators

Gender Equality Index includes **outcome** indicators and adopts an individual perspective



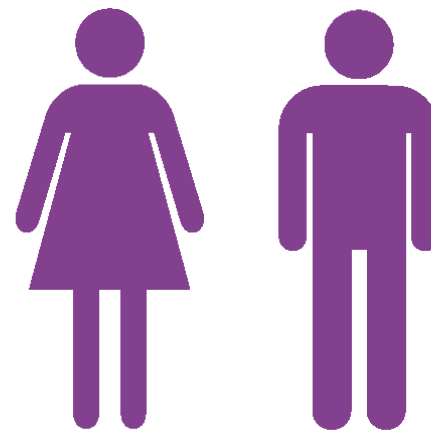

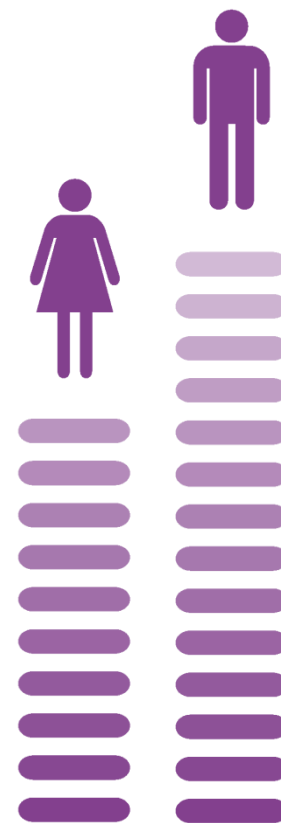

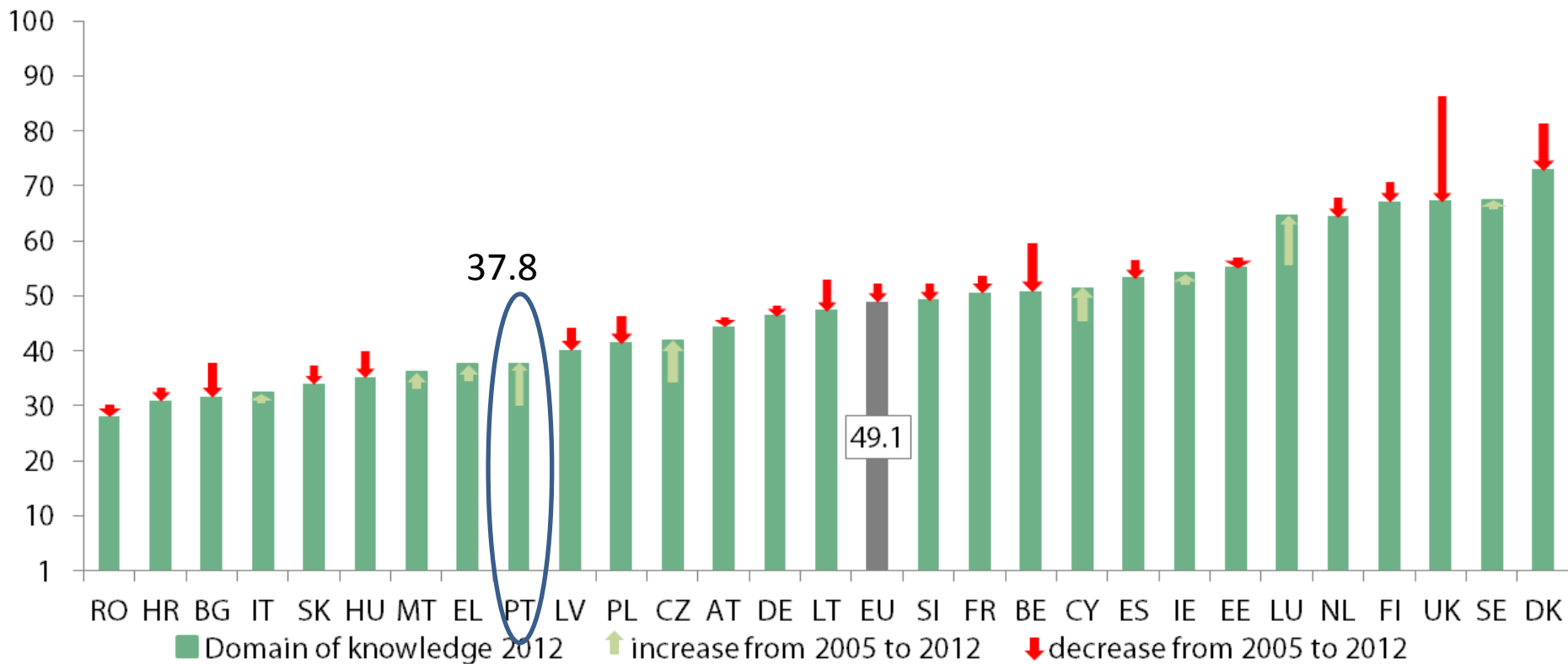




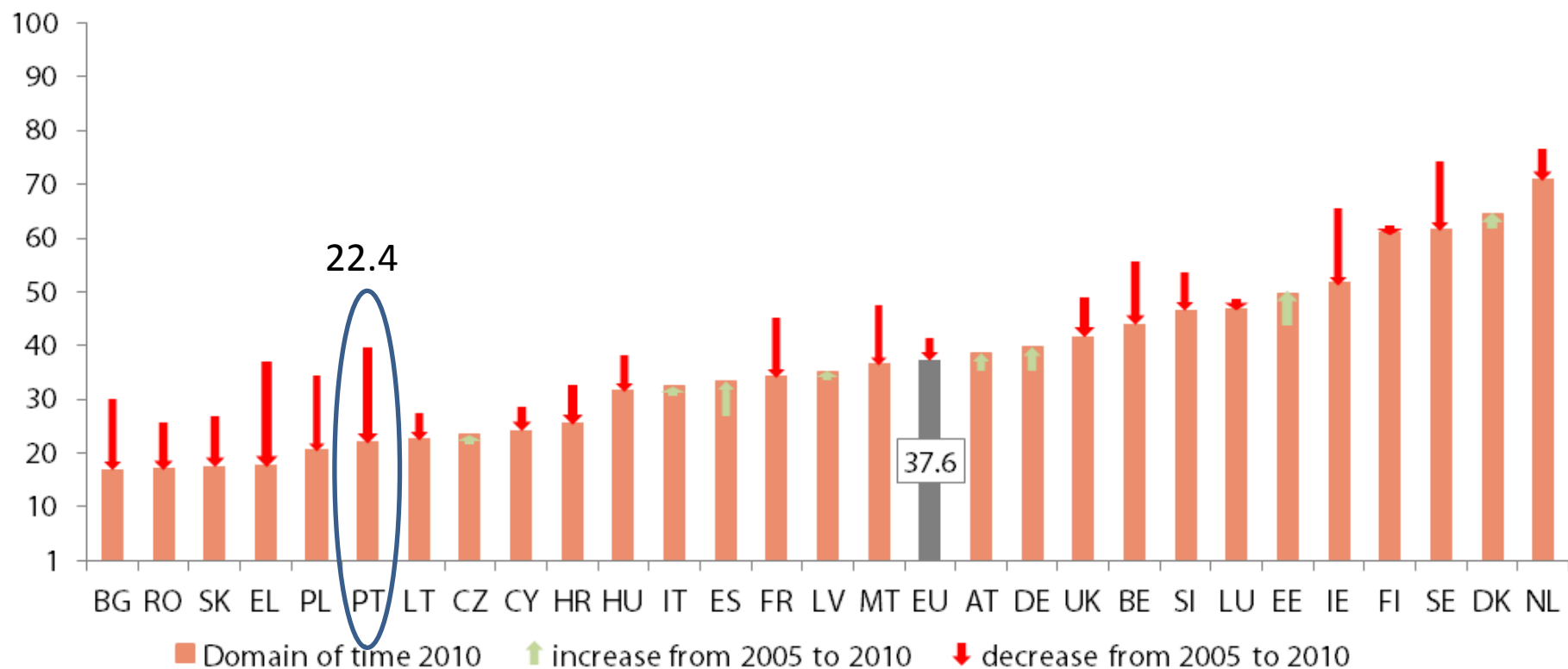
# Money: trend in Member States 2005 - 2012

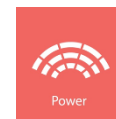
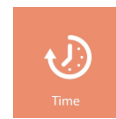
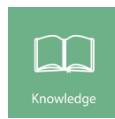
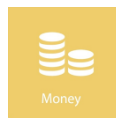
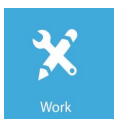
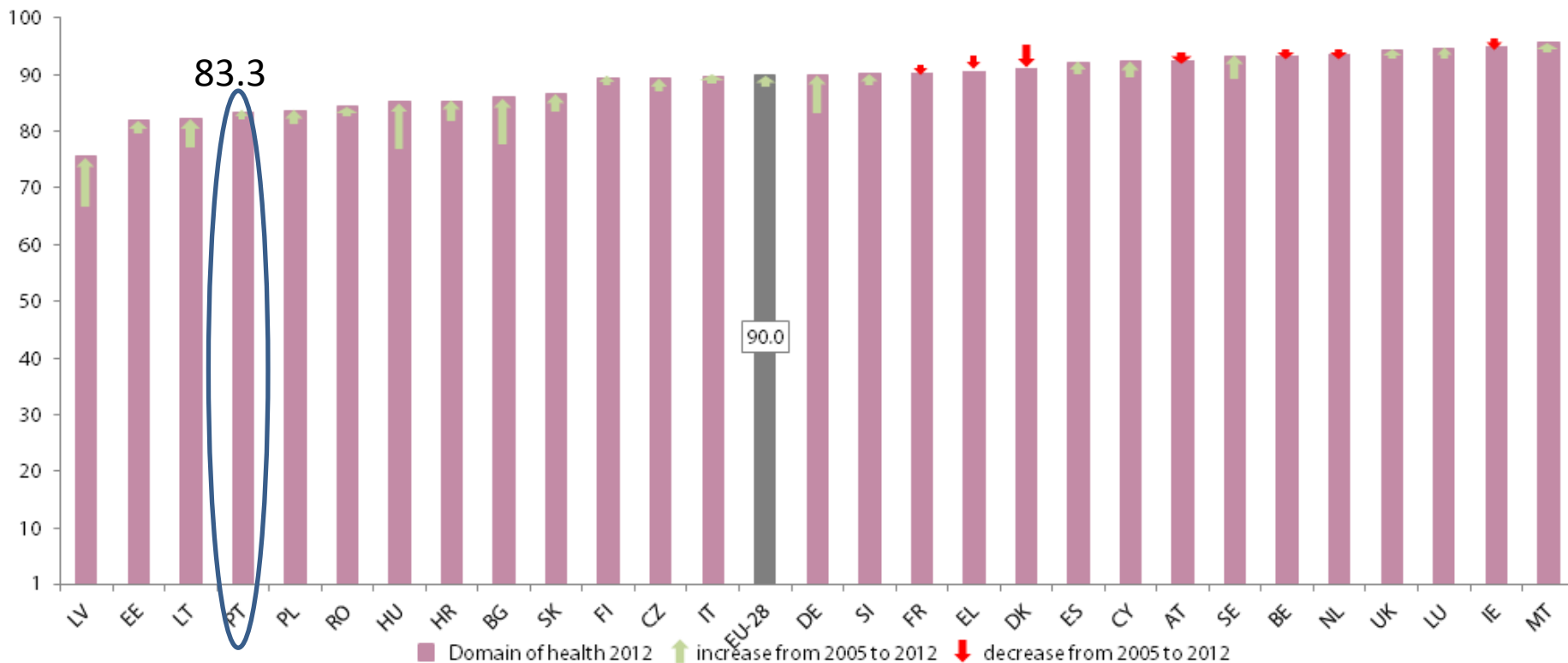
# Power: trend in Member States 2005 - 2010

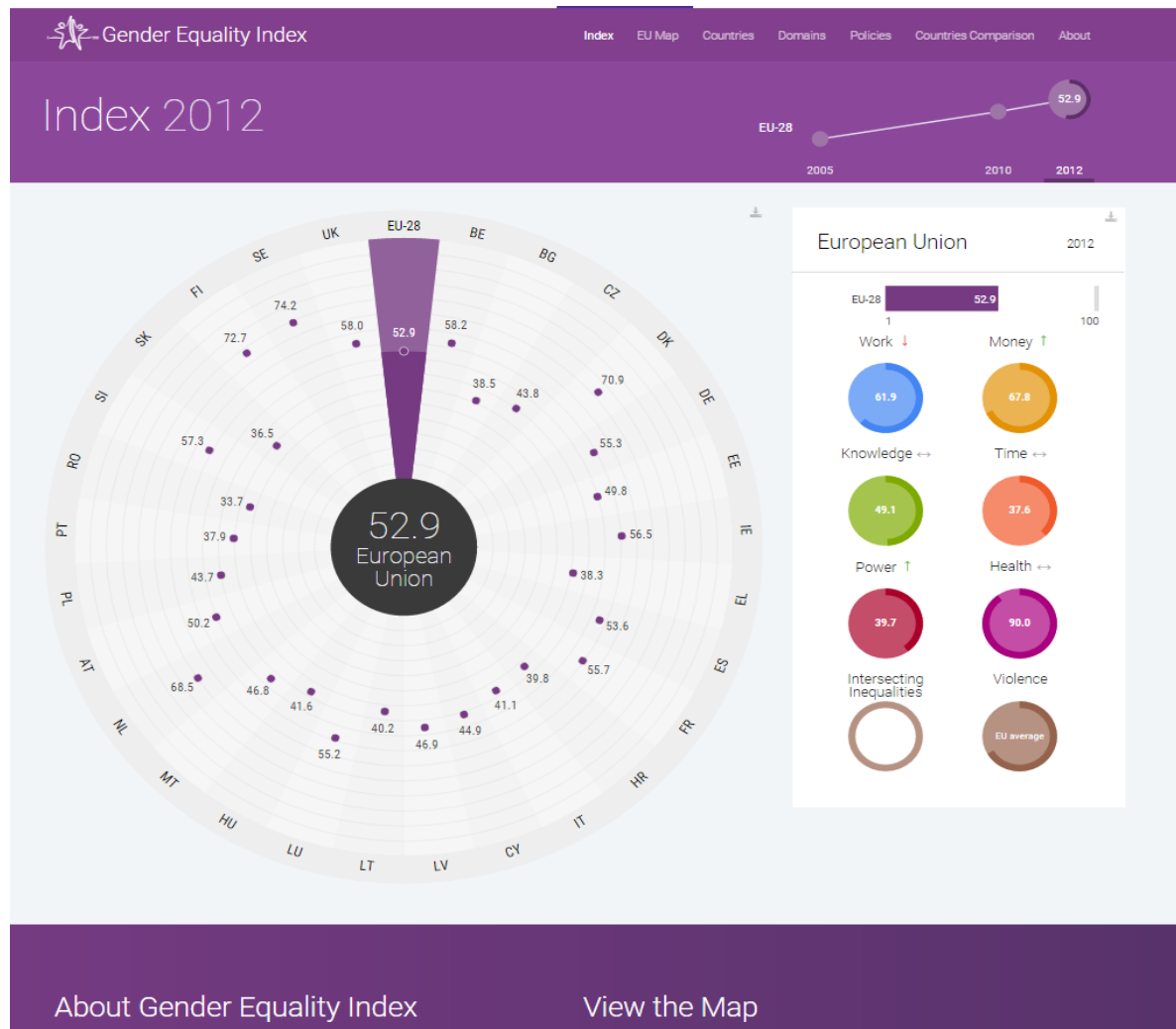
