## A NEW EUROPEAN EFFORT TO TACKLE GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE IN THE WORLD OF WORK

Across Europe, gender-based violence (GBV) and harassment undermine safety and equality at work, with particular relevance in the healthcare sector. The BRAVE-WOW project — Building Respectful and Violence-free gender-inclusive Environments in the World of Work — brings together partners from Portugal, Italy, Spain, and Slovenia to generate evidence and implement practical measures for respectful, inclusive workplaces.

Co-funded by the EU's Citizens, Equality, Rights and Values (CERV) Programme, BRAVE-WOW combines updated research with stakeholder engagement to support prevention and organisational change. Over 30 months, the consortium will gather data, co-create tools and policies, and provide training to promote violence-free work environments. Its ambition is to translate evidence into sustained improvements in workplace safety and equality.
